## BLUE BOX ITEMS

	What to Recycle	How to Prepare
 <p><b>POLYCOAT BEVERAGE CARTONS</b> discard plastic lids</p>	<p>Milk cartons, juice cartons, creamer cartons, etc.  Look for "gable top" like the roof of a house.</p>	<p>Rinse. Flatten or crush to make more room.</p>
 <p><b>ALUMINUM FOIL</b></p>	<p>Aluminum foil (loose sheets), aluminum trays, aluminum pie plates, and aluminum pans.</p>	<p>Rinse. Plates &amp; trays flatten. Foil, roll in a ball.</p>
 <p><b>TUBS &amp; LIDS</b></p>	<p>Margarine tubs, sour cream, yogurt, ice cream, spreads, and dips.</p>	<p>Empty and rinse. Remove lid, and recycle lid as well.</p>
 <p><b>FOOD &amp; BEVERAGE CANS</b></p>	<p>Pop &amp; juice cans, vegetable cans, fruit cans, etc.  All aluminum and steel cans are accepted.</p>	<p>Rinse. Flatten or crush to make more room.</p>
 <p><b>PLASTIC BOTTLES &amp; JUGS</b> discard plastic lids</p>	<p>Pop, water, sport drink bottles, lotion, shampoo, fabric softener &amp; condiment bottles.  Any plastic bottle that has an opening smaller than the base.</p>	<p><b>Check the neck!</b> If it is a plastic bottle or jug that has an opening smaller than the base - recycle it. Rinse. Discard plastic lid. <b>All cans MUST be empty.</b></p>
<p><b>EMPTY PAINT &amp; AEROSOL CANS</b> discard plastic lids</p>	<p>Empty alkyd &amp; latex paint cans - no plastic cans.  Empty Aerosol spray cans; deodorizers, cooking spray, shaving cream, etc.</p>	<p>Paint Trick: Let product dry out and knock out dried paint into garbage-recycle empty can.</p>
<p><b>GLASS BOTTLES &amp; JARS</b> Recycle metal lids</p>	<p>All colours of glass bottles and jars are accepted. (i.e. condiment bottles &amp; jars, dressings, sauces, etc.)</p>	<p>Rinse. No ceramics, window glass, broken glass, etc. Metal lids can be recycled.</p>

## RED BOX ITEMS

	What To Recycle	How To Prepare
<p><b>NEWSPAPER</b></p>	<p>Newspapers, junk mail, inserts and flyers.</p>	<p>Remove any plastic inserts/wrap.</p>
<p><b>MAGAZINES, CATALOGUES &amp; TELEPHONE BOOKS</b></p>	<p>Magazines, catalogues, telephone books, paperback books, &amp; books.</p>	<p>Remove cover from hardcover books and discard.</p>
<p><b>MIXED PAPER</b></p>	<p>Cereal, pasta, cookie, laundry detergent, tissue and shoe boxes. Pet food bags, brown paper bags, toilet/paper towel tubes. Office paper, envelopes, paper egg trays, gift cards, gift wrap, etc.</p>	<p>Flatten boxes. Remove any plastic inserts/wrap.</p>
<p><b>CARDBOARD</b></p>	<p>Cardboard boxes, shipping/moving boxes, clean pizza boxes, etc.</p>	<p>Large appliance boxes break down (no larger than 30" x 30" x 30").</p>

## NOT ACCEPTED in the Blue Box



Plastic Bags: (grocery, shopping, etc.)

Green Plastic Baskets: (usually contain fruit)

Clear Plastic Containers: (usually contain fruit, can be Styro-foam as well)

## OTHER ITEMS

Household and Cell Phone Batteries: Consumer batteries weighing less than 5 kg (i.e. Ni-Cd, Ni-MH, Li-Ion, Ni-Zn, SS/LA/Pb, Lithium Primary, Alkaline)

Drop off at the Pelee Waste Transfer Station, Municipal Office, East Park Campground, Scudder Marina.

Electronics: Drop off at the Pelee Island Waste Transfer Station.
