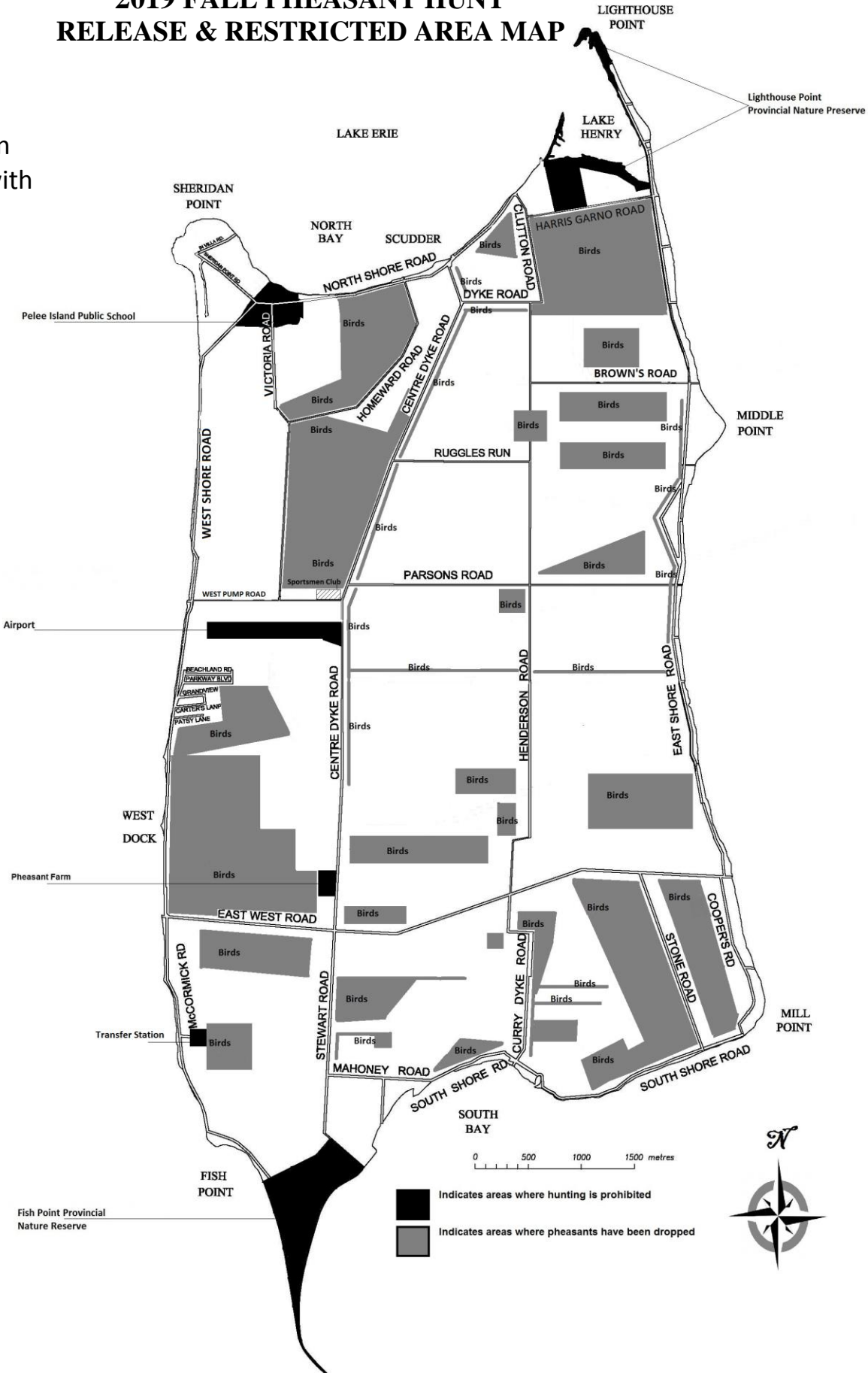


2019 FALL PHEASANT HUNT RELEASE & RESTRICTED AREA MAP

Drop areas are an approximation.
Birds have not been dropped in areas with standing crops.



NOTE: Areas not indicated may be posted for "No Hunting" or "No Trespassing", WATCH FOR SIGNS.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

SCHOOL ZONE

- **PLEASE HELP US KEEP OUR CHILDREN SAFE FROM HARM.**
- Watch for posted signs and red flags marking restricted school zone
- THE MUNICIPALITY CONSIDERS ANY HUNTING WITHIN THE SCHOOL ZONE TO BE A VERY SERIOUS ISSUE AND IT **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**

PROHIBITED AREAS

- Hunting is prohibited in the provincial nature reserves, Fish Point and Lighthouse Point;
- Pelee Island Transfer Station;
- Pelee Island Pheasant Farm; and
- Pelee Island International Airport
- These areas are blacked out on the map on the reverse side;
- Watch for signs posted on private property that state, "NO HUNTING", or "NO TRESPASSING" and residential areas should be considered off limits.

STANDING CROPS

- Hunting is not permitted in fields of standing crops without the permission of the landowner.
- Hunting is permitted along hedgerows if the landowner has not posted "No Hunting" or "No Trespassing" signs. If a bird drops in standing crops, it is recommended that the hunter retrieve the bird rather than a dog to minimize damage to crops.
- **WATCH FOR WORKERS IN FIELDS**

- Monday/Wednesday/Friday 8 am – 12 pm
- Saturday/Sunday 11 am – 4pm
- DO NOT LEAVE BAGS AT THE GATE

NO PARKING

- Vehicles are not permitted in fields or on private property and must be kept on municipal roadways at all times.
- For safety reasons, we ask that hunters do not park vehicles overnight on roadways.
- If vehicles are found blocking roads, or access to fields they will be ticketed.

DOGS

- Any lost dogs can be brought to the Township Office at 1045 West Shore Rd, between 8:30 am – 4:30 pm.
