The Annual Pelee Island Fall Pheasant Hunts, in their 92nd year, continue to attract hunters from around North America to cross open fields and watch their dogs work in the hedgerows and varied natural spaces. Pelee Island's hospitality and charm keeps hunters coming back for generations to carry forward a much-loved tradition with family and friends. Each hunt has limited licenses available, so plan ahead to hunt Canada's deep south.

ALL MAIN PHEASANT LICENCES MUST BE PURCHASED ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1ST, 2024.

MAXIMUM OF 300 LICENCES SOLD PER HUNT.

THERE WILL BE NO MAIN HUNT LICENCES AVALABLE FOR PURCHASE AFTER THIS DATE.

CLEAN UP LICENCES WILL BE AVAILABLE UNTIL THE END OF THE HUNTING SEASON.

If you are in possession of a gun for the purpose of hunting in Ontario, you are required to carry proof of your firearms accreditation under the Firearms Act (Canada) - this includes apprentice hunters (residents 12-14 years old) who cannot yet obtain a firearms licence. Ontario.ca/huntingregulations

All hunters must also have a **Province of Ontario Small Games Hunting License, Ontario Outdoors Card,** and a **Municipal Licence** when hunting Pheasant or Rabbit.

Mentor an Apprentice Hunter – Receive 10% Off!

Do you know an apprentice hunter ages 12-14? If so, we happily offer an incentive to any hunter who mentors an apprentice (12-14 years old with Outdoors card) during a main pheasant hunt. Mentors will **receive 10% off** the cost of their licence to help encourage a younger generation of hunters. This option is only available to Ontario Residents.

How to Transfer a Licence

Sales for 2024 Pheasant Licences are FINAL there will be NO refunds or transfers outside of 2024 hunts. However, transfers can be made within 2024 between hunts, as well as between hunters.

Steps to Transfer a Licence

- Licence transfers **MUST** be done prior to the start of the applicable hunt (i.e. Transfers for Main Hunt 1 must be made before 8am on October 24th, Clean Up Hunt 1 before 8am on November 14th, etc.)
- Original Licence(s) **MUST** be returned to the municipal office **BEFORE** 8am on the Thursday of the applicable hunt
- Transfer fee of \$28.25 MUST be paid before a new licence is issued

Additional Information for Transfers

- Transfers can be made between hunters and/or between hunts at any time **BEFORE** the start of the applicable hunt
- Once a hunt has started, there are no transfer options available
- Transfers are preferred to be requested by email to <u>peleehunts@pelee.ca</u> but can also be done over the phone 519-724-2931 or in person at the municipal office

Obtaining Ontario Small Game & Ontario Outdoors Cards

Ontario Small Game Licences and Ontario Outdoor Cards can now be renewed or purchased **ONLINE** at <u>https://www.huntandfishontario.com/</u>, as well as on the island at the municipal office (**CASH ONLY**) and at many other locations throughout the province of Ontario.

- Non-Residents of Ontario must present ID & one <u>original</u> piece of the following documentation to obtain a Non-Resident Small Games License and Outdoors Card to hunt in Ontario:
 - A current Non-Resident Outdoors Card issued by Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources;
 - An Ontario Non-Resident's hunting license issued to you after January 1, 1968;
 - A hunting license issued to you by a competent authority in any jurisdiction as a resident of that jurisdiction after January 1, 1968;

Without this proof, you will **NOT** be able to purchase the Non-Resident Outdoors Card and Small Games License and therefore will **not be able to hunt**. If unsure of what proof to bring please call: 1-800-387-7011.

Attend Hunter Information sessions every Wednesday at 6pm prior to the start of each Main Hunt on Oct 23, 30 and Nov 6, 2024.

REMINDER: no air rifles, guns, cross bows, bow and arrows or other firearms shall be discharged from 5:00pm Sunday October 24th, 2024, until 5:00pm on Saturday November 9th, 2024, outside of the Pheasant Hunt hours of 8am-5pm Thursday to Saturday. <u>By-Law-2018-36-Discharge-of-Firearms.pdf (pelee.org)</u>

Standing Crops

Hunting is not permitted in fields/areas of standing crops. The most prominent example of standing crops on Pelee Island is soy beans during the pheasant hunting season.

Prohibited Areas

It is important for the future of this much loved tradition that all hunters respect the wishes of private landowners and applicable municipal, provincial and federal laws.

Hunting is prohibited in the following locations during the Annual Pelee Island Pheasant Hunt, residential areas are to be considered off limits, in addition to any private property with signs posted stating "NO HUNTING" or "NO TRESPASSING":

- Pelee Island Public School Zone
- Provincial Nature Reserves (Fish Point and Lighthouse Point);
- Pelee Island Transfer Station; and
- Pelee Island International Airport

Firearm Requirements in Ontario:

Fish and Wildlife Conservation Regulation 665/98.

25.2 (1) No person shall hunt with a gun unless the person meets at least one of the following requirements:

- 1. The person holds a valid possession and acquisition licence issued under the *Firearms Act* (Canada).
- 2. The person holds a valid minor's licence issued under the *Firearms Act* (Canada).
- 3. The person has proof that he or she has successfully completed the Canadian Firearms Safety Course, and tests that form part of that course, under the *Firearms Act (Canada)*.
- 4. In the case of an individual who is a non-resident and who ordinarily resides outside of Canada,
 - i. a valid non-resident firearms declaration form confirmed by a Canadian customs officer, or
 - ii. a valid temporary firearms borrowing licence for non-residents issued under the *Firearms Act* (Canada).
