

GETTING HERE

Ferry

Ferries to and from Pelee Island are operated by Owen Sound Transportation Company with mainland terminals in Leamington, Kingsville and Sandusky, OH. Reservations are required. Visit ontarioferries.com or call 1-800-661-2220 for details. If you choose to not bring a vehicle to Pelee Island, be sure to plan for on-island transportation in advance! The island is generally not walkable for the casual walker and is bigger than you think!

Scudder Marina

If travelling by personal watercraft, you'll be coming to the only public marina on Pelee Island – Scudder Marina. The marina monitors VHF 68 and accommodates transient boaters for the day or overnight. Book your reservation by calling 519-724-2377.

Airplane

The Whelan International Airport is used for both private aircraft and regular scheduled flights. Pelee Island Transportation operates scheduled flights from Windsor only during winter months. Summer charter flights are available from Ohio through Griffing Air.

Pelee Island is approximately 10,000 acres of fields, forests, wetlands, beaches and trails. Pelee Island is home to over 700 acres of pristine vineyards of the largest privately owned estate winery in the country.

Fishing

Cast off the pier at Scudder Dock, wander out under moonlit skies to shore fish in the fall or grab a charter to haul the day's limit of walleye, perch and smallmouth bass.

Walking Trails

Provincial Nature Reserves complete with parking, footpaths, boardwalks and beach trails are found at points north and south. Lighthouse Point Nature Reserve and Fishpoint Nature Reserve provide access to one of the oldest lighthouses on the Great Lakes and the southernmost part of inhabited Canada.

Nature Conservancy of Canada lands occupy Alvars off of Stone Road and form the impressive Florian Diamante Wetland Complex. Globally rare shoreline is protected at Middle Point Woods with natural beach stretching over gradual dunes and rare plant life. Hunting

In addition to spring turkey hunting, seasonal duck and rabbit hunting, The Annual Fall Pheasant Hunt on Pelee Island is now a tradition in its 92nd year that attracts upland bird hunters from all over North America. Learn more at pelee.org.

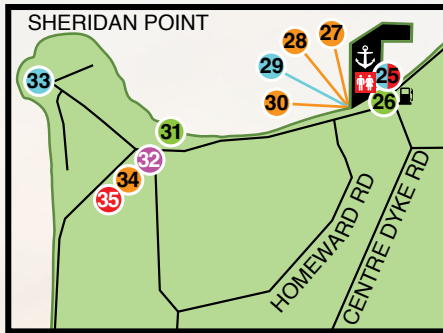
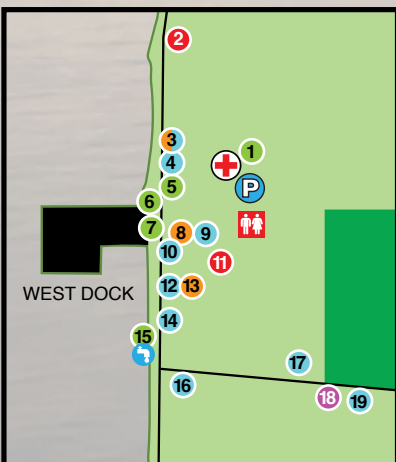
