

The Corporation of the Township of Pelee

By-law No. 1579

Being a By-Law to authorizing Road Resurfacing
Contract for designated roads on Pelee Island

WHEREAS, the Ontario Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.45, as amended and specifically Sections 260, 262, 284 which pertain to the jurisdiction and liabilities for roads and road maintenance;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Pelee recognizes the fact that the roads on Pelee Island either need surfacing or resurfacing with tar and chip;

AND WHEREAS the Council has had an engineers report completed by BTS Consulting Engineers, and have accepted this report with a tendering process;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEELE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

THAT the tender received from Shepley Excavating and Road Maintenance Ltd with a revised pricing of \$432,849.27;

AND THAT Council confirms and agrees to the previously discussed roads to be either surfaced or resurfaced with tar and chip;

AND THAT BTS Consulting Engineers are to draw up the required contracts for signature between Shepley Excavating and Road Maintenance Ltd. and the Township of Pelee;

AND THAT the Reeve, Al McAninch and the Clerk-Treasurer, Daphne Blais Rae, be authorized to sign said contracts;

AND THAT the Road Resurfacing to be completed as soon as possible and before the busy tourist season on the island;

AND THAT the Road Resurfacing Contract shall be indicated as 'Schedule A' and form part of this by-law;

AND THAT this By-law shall come into force and take effect on the 25th day of April, 2001 and its short title shall be "Road Resurfacing By-law".
