

# The Corporation of the Township of Pelee

## By-law No. 1585

Being a By-Law to provide Election Procedures  
during the Year 2001 Municipal By-Elections.

WHEREAS Section 37 (3) (4), of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council shall pass a by-law establishing location and dates for a by-election;

AND WHEREAS the voting place means the area designated by the Clerk in which the facilities for the conduct of the vote are located;

AND WHEREAS no campaign material or literature of any nature relating to any candidate in the election shall be displayed within the voting place;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk has determined this "curb access";

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of The Township of Pelee enacts as follows:

THAT the voting place for the scheduled By-Election Polling Day shall be held on Monday, November 5, 2001, between the hours of 10:00 am and 5:00 pm at Township of Pelee's Municipal Office, 1045 West Shore Road, Pelee Island, ON;

AND THAT the curb access for the scheduled Polling Day shall be:

- a) the westerly boundary shall be the water's edge on the west side of West Shore Road;
- b) the southern boundary shall be the boundary between the municipal property bordering on the Watson property in the south western corner and shall include the northern face of the Watson property and buildings;
- c) the northern boundary shall be the boundary between the municipal property bordering on the Moritz property in the north western corner and shall include the southern face of the Moritz property and buildings;
- d) the eastern boundary shall be the municipal parking lot adjacent to the Pelee Island Medical Clinic.

AND THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the 10th day of September, 2001 and its short title shall be "2001 By-Election Procedures".
