

The Corporation of the Township of Pelee

By-law No. 1545

Being a By-Law to provide for advance votes to be held prior to voting day and for Election Procedures.

WHEREAS Section 43(1) of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council shall pass a by-law establishing one or more dates for advance votes, and hours during which voting places shall be open on that date or dates;

AND WHEREAS the voting place means the area designated by the Clerk in which the facilities for the conduct of the vote are located;

AND WHEREAS no campaign material or literature of any nature relating to any candidate in the election shall be displayed within the voting place;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk has determined this "curb access";

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of The Township of Pelee enacts as follows:

THAT an advance vote shall be held on Saturday, November 1, 1997 between the hours of 10:00 am and 5:00 pm at the Pelee Island Medical Clinic's Ambulance Office , 1047 West Shore Road, Pelee Island, ON;


AND THAT the voting place for the scheduled Polling Day shall be held on the prescribed date of Monday, November 10, 1997 between the hours of 10:00 am and 8:00 pm at the Pelee Island Medical Clinic's Ambulance Office , 1047 West Shore Road, Pelee Island, ON;

AND THAT the curb access for both the advance poll and the scheduled Polling Day shall be:

- a) the westerly boundary shall be the water's edge on the west side of West Shore Road;
- b) the southern boundary shall be the boundary between the municipal property bordering on the Wadsworth property in the south western corner and shall include the northern face of the Wadsworth property and buildings;
- c) the northern boundary shall be the boundary between the municipal property bordering on the Wallace property in the north western corner and shall include the southern face of the Wallace property and buildings;
- d) the eastern boundary shall be the municipal parking lot adjacent to the Pelee Island Medical Clinic.

AND THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the 6th day of October, 1997 and its short title shall be 1997 Elections
