

The Corporation of the Township of Pelee

By-law No. 1546

Being a By-Law to submit a question to the
electors at the next regular municipal election.

WHEREAS Section 8(1) of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council may pass a by-law to submit to its electors a proposed by-law requiring their assent, or a question not otherwise authorized by law but within the council's jurisdiction;


NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of The Township of Pelee enacts as follows:

THAT there shall be submitted to the electors at the regular municipal election to be held on November 10th, 1997, the following question:

" In order for the Township of Pelee to remain financially viable the Township Council is finding it increasingly necessary to find new means of funding municipal services.

Would you support the Council of the Township of Pelee in its bid to find new and alternative sources of revenue and to restructure the existing economic arrangements between the Township of Pelee and the governments of Ontario and Canada?".
