

The Corporation of the Township of Pelee

By-law No. 1573

Being a by-law to Provide for the Installation of a New Farm Bridge
Over the Big Marsh Drainage Scheme Drain No. 2

WHEREAS Kevin Ryerse has submitted a written request for the installation of a New Farm Bridge Over the Big Marsh Drainage Scheme Drain No. 2;

AND WHEREAS Section 78 of the Drainage Act states that the Council of any municipality whose duty it is to maintain and repair the drainage works or any part thereof, may on the report of an Engineer appointed by it, complete the drainage works as set forth in such report;

AND WHEREAS a drainage report date July 21, 1999 has been procured and made by Lour Zarlenga of Bruce D. Crozier Engineering Ltd. and the report is attached hereto and forms part of this By-law;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Pelee is of the opinion that the installation of the bridge over the Big Marsh Drainage Scheme Drain No. 2 is warranted and desirable;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PELEE PURSUANT TO THE DRAINAGE ACT, ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

THAT the report dated July 21, 2000 and attached hereto is hereby adopted and the installation of the Bridge as therein indicated and set forth is hereby authorised and shall be completed in accordance therewith;

AND THAT The Corporation of the Township of Pelee may borrow on the credit of the amount an amount of \$14,500.00 being the amount necessary for the construction of the said drainage works;

AND THAT The Corporation of the Township of Pelee may issue debentures for the amount borrowed less the total amount of:

- a) Grants received under Section 85 of the Act;
- b) Commuted payments made in respect of lands and roads assessed within the Municipality
- c) Money paid under Section 61 (3) of the Act;

and such debentures shall be made payable within 10 years from the date of the debenture and shall bear interest at a rate not higher than the rate charged by the Ontario Municipal Improvement Corporation on the date of the sale of such debenture.

AND THAT a Special equal annual rate sufficient to redeem the principal and interest on the debentures shall be levied upon the lands and roads as set forth in the Schedule to be collected in the same manner as other taxes are collected in each year for ten years after passing of this By-law;

AND THAT this By-law shall come into force and take effect on the 6th day of November and its short title shall be "Kevin Ryersee Farm Bridge".
