

The Corporation of the Township of Pelee

By-law No. 1609

Being a By-Law to Terminate
an Agreement relating to property exchange.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Pelee entered into an Agreement with Joanne M. Baker dated the 25th day of November, 1985 to transfer a closed roadway (East Lake Shore Road) in exchange for a conveyance of land for a new road;

AND WHEREAS all conditions contained in the Agreement have been fulfilled.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PELEE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

THAT the Agreement with Joanne M. Baker dated the 25th day of November 1985 and registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Essex (No. 12) on the 4th day of April 1986 as instrument 967309, having been fulfilled, is hereby terminated;

AND THAT Alexander G. Reid, Solicitor, be and is hereby authorized to, electronically, to delete the Agreement from the Register in the Office of Land Titles, Windsor, Ontario;

AND THAT this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the 21st day of June, 2004 and the short title of this By-Law is "Baker Agreement Termination".
