

# The Corporation of the Township of Pelee

## By-law No. 1620

Being a by-law to Appoint David Hodare as Drainage Superintendent  
pursuant to the Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1990

**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 93 of the Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1990, a Council may appoint a drainage superintendent and provide for his remuneration for the purposes and in the manner set out therein;

**AND WHEREAS** paragraph 45 of Section 207 of the Municipal Act authorises all municipalities to appoint such officers or employees as may be necessary for the purpose of the corporation, or for carrying into effect any Act of the Legislature or by-law of the council, and for fixing their remuneration and prescribing their duties, and the security to be given for the performance of them;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Pelee **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

**THAT** David Hodare is hereby appointed Drainage Superintendent for the Corporation of the Township of Pelee;

**AND THAT** the Drainage Superintendent appointed hereunder shall receive such remuneration as shall be mutually agreed upon by himself and Council and shall hold office until such time as he resigns or his employment is terminated by resolution of Council;

**AND THAT** The Drainage Superintendent shall carry out the duties imposed upon him pursuant to the Drainage Act, 1990, namely:

- to initiate and supervise the maintenance and repair of any drainage works; and
- to assist in the construction or improvement of any drainage works; and
- to report thereon to Council and may provide for fees or other remuneration for services performed by the drainage superintendent in carrying out the provisions of the Drainage Act;

**AND THAT** By-law number 1582 is hereby repealed.

**AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the 16th day of May, 2005 and its short title shall be "Drainage Superintendent".

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 16th day of May, 2005.
