

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PELEE**

**BY-LAW NO. 1701**

**A By-Law of The Corporation of the Township of Pelee to  
authorize tax relief for the municipal portion of the property  
taxes related to the Royal Canadian Legion, Pelee Island  
Branch No. 403 and to rescind By-Law 1671.**

WHEREAS pursuant to the Assessment Act, RSO 1990 Chapter A 131, Section 6, land that is used and occupied as a memorial home, clubhouse or athletic grounds by persons who served in the armed forces of His or Her Majesty or an ally of His or Her Majesty in any war is exempted from taxation in the circumstances and to the extent described in this section; and

WHEREAS the Council of a Municipality may pass by-laws exempting from taxation, other than school taxes and local improvement rates, land described in subsection (1) on such conditions as may be set out in the by-laws; and

WHEREAS an exemption under subsection (2) must not exceed 10 years but may be renewed at any time during the last year of the exemption; and

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Pelee deems it advisable to enact a By-law pursuant to section 6 of the Assessment Act to exempt the municipal (lower tier) portion of the taxes for the Royal Canadian Legion, Pelee Island, Branch No. 403.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Pelee enacts the following:

1. That the lands owned by the Royal Canadian Legion, Pelee Island Branch No. 403. which are used and occupied as a memorial home, clubhouse or athletic grounds by person who served in the armed forces of His or Her majesty or an ally of His or Her Majesty in any war be exempted from the municipal (lower tier) portion of their property tax bill, excluding any local improvement rates.
2. That the tax exemption outlined in (1) above be for the years 2009-2010 inclusive.
3. That this by-law be cited as the "Municipal Tax Exemption for Land Used by Veterans Bylaw".
4. This By-law shall take effect and come into force on and from January 1, 2009.
5. This By-law shall hereby rescind by-law 1671.

**READ A FIRST AND TAKEN AS READ A SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED  
THIS 6<sup>th</sup>, DAY OF OCTOBER, 2008.**

AND THAT this by-law shall come into the effect on the 1st day of January, 2009.
