

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PELEE

BY-LAW NO. 2009-4

**A By-Law of The Corporation of the Township of Pelee to establish
the rates of remuneration for Members of Council.**

WHEREAS Section 283 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001 provides that a municipality may pay any part of the remuneration and expenses to the Members of Council, and such remuneration may be determined in any manner that Council considers advisable; and

WHEREAS despite any Act, a municipality may only pay the expenses of the members of its Council if the expenses are of those persons in their capacity as members, officers, or employees, and if the expenses are in lieu of the expenses actually incurred, a reasonable estimate, in the opinion of the Council of the actual expenses that would be incurred; and

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, 2001, Section 283 (7) also states: "on or after December 1, 2003 Council shall review a by-law under subsection (5) at a public meeting at least once during the three year period corresponding to the term of office of its members after a regular election"; and

WHEREAS Council of The Corporation of the Township of Pelee deems it necessary and desirable to enact a by-law to establish the rate of remuneration for the Members of Council for the term of Council 2006 to 2010.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Pelee enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor shall receive \$5,625.00 per annum remuneration paid in equal quarterly installments.
2. That the Deputy Mayor shall receive \$3,875.00 per annum remuneration paid in equal quarterly installments.
3. That each Councillor shall receive \$3,750.00 per annum remuneration paid in equal quarterly installments.
4. That the preceding remuneration and expense allowances shall cover all regular Council Meetings as well as additional Council duties as outline in the *Municipal Act, 2001* Section 224 & 225.
5. That in addition meetings conducted on behalf of the Township, a \$75.00 per diem rate be established for attendance at various Committee(s), AD Hoc or other meetings,


meetings, provided that the Member of Council has been duly appointed or approved by Council Resolution.

6. That all Members of Council shall be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred while engaged in Council or Committee investigations upon submission of proper documentation to Council. Such expenses may include the use of a personal vehicle from the point of departure, registration, meals, incidentals, or other such expenses as approved by Council.
7. That all Members of Council shall be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred while engaged in Township business outside the boundaries of the Township on submission of proper documentation to Council. Such expenses may include use of a personal vehicle from the point of departure, registration, accommodation, meals, incidentals, or such other expenses as approved by Council.
8. That all Members of Council who are required by the Township to use their personal vehicle on Township business shall be compensated at such a rate as prescribed by policy, for each actual kilometer driven, subject to the completion of the prescribed forms.
9. That all Members of Council shall be entitled to enrollment in the following group benefit plans:
 - a) Heath Service which include a deductible of \$25.00 that is payable by the individual.
16. The Provisions of this By-Law upon the final passing thereof shall come into force as of January 9th, 2009.
