

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PELEE**

**BY-LAW NO. 2011-5**

**A By-law to deem all lands on  
Registered Plan 1011 not to be lands  
on a registered plan of subdivision for  
the purposes of Section 50 (3) of the *Planning Act*.**

**WHEREAS** Section 50(4) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, authorizes a municipality to designate any plan of subdivision or part thereof that has been registered for eight (8) years or more to be deemed not to be a registered plan of subdivision for the purposes of subdivision control;

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient to pass such a By-law in order to adequately control the development of the lands within Registered Plan 1011 in the Township of Pelee;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PELEE HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. Lots 1 to 215 both inclusive, Registered Plan 1011, being all of Registered Plan 1011 in the Township of Pelee, in the Province of Ontario, shall be deemed not to be lands on a registered plan of subdivision for the purposes of subsection 3 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 13, as amended.
2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect after the final passing thereof upon the date on which this By-law is registered in the Land Registry Office for the County of Essex (No. 12).


**Read a first and second time and FINALLY PASSED this 1st day of February, 2011.**
