

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PELEE

BY-LAW NO. 2014- 11

REPEALED

Being a by-law to designate a Community Emergency Management Coordinator (CEMC) for the Township of Pelee and to repeal By-Law No. 1702.

WHEREAS the Province of Ontario has enacted the Emergency Management Act mandating that each community have an emergency response plan.

AND WHEREAS each municipal emergency plan has contingencies for the four steps in emergency planning: mitigation/prevention, preparedness, response and recovery.

AND WHEREAS the Province encourages partnerships in emergency plans and has mandated the development of mutual assistance programs for its standards in the comprehensive level of emergency preparedness.

AND WHEREAS Section 10 (1) of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act (O. Reg. 380/04) indicates that every municipality shall designate an employee of said municipality as it's Community Emergency Management Coordinator (CEMC);

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PELEE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.) **THAT** Wayne Miller be hereby designated as the Community Emergency Management Coordinator (CEMC) for the Township of Pelee effective immediately.
- 2.) **THAT** Katrina DiGiovanni be hereby designated as the alternate Community Emergency Management Coordinator (CEMC) for the Township of Pelee effectively immediately.
- 3.) **THAT** the CEMC and/or alternate shall coordinate the development and implementation of the municipality's emergency management program.
- 4.) **THAT** the CEMC shall report to the municipality's emergency management program committee.
- 5.) **AND THAT** By-Law 1702 is hereby repealed with the passing of this by-law.


