

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PELEE**

**BY-LAW NO. 2015-40**

Being a by-law to designate a Community Emergency Management Coordinator (CEMC) for the Township of Pelee and to repeal By-Law No. 2014-11

**WHEREAS** the Province of Ontario has enacted the Emergency Management Act mandating that each community have an emergency response plan.

**AND WHEREAS** each municipal emergency plan has contingencies for the four steps in the emergency planning: mitigation/prevention, preparedness, response and recovery.

**AND WHEREAS** the Province encourages partnership in emergency plans and has mandated the development of mutual assistance programs for its standards in the comprehensive level of emergency preparedness.


**AND WHEREAS** Section 10 (1) of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act (O. Reg. 380/04) indicated that every municipality shall designate an employee of said municipality as its Community Emergency Management Coordinator (CEMC);

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PELEE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **THAT** Katrina DiGiovanni be hereby designated as the Community Emergency Management Coordinator (CEMC) for the Township of Pelee effective immediately.
2. **THAT** Wayne Miller hereby designated as the alternate Community Emergency Management Coordinator (CEMC) for the Township of Pelee effective immediately.
3. **THAT** the CEMC and/or the alternate shall coordinate the development and implementation of the municipality's emergency management program.
4. **THAT** the CEMC shall report to the municipality's emergency management program committee.
5. **AND THAT** By-Law 2014-11 is hereby repealed with the passing of this by-law.
