SCHEDULE A
UTILITIES CROSSING AGREEMENT FOR Utility Crossing for Drainage Purposes ON MCCORMICK ROAD,
BETWEEN THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PELEE AND Pelee Farms Inc.

This Agreement made this 27th day of November, 201, between Pelee Farms Inc. and The Corporation of the Township of Pelee.

WHEREAS:

- 1.) The parties own agricultural property on McCormick Road, known as, Lot 30, RP 12R26353, Part 2, Plan 35, situated in the Township;
- 2.) The Township owns and maintains the public roadway known as McCormick Road;
- 3.) In order for Pelee Farms to run his new drainage tile to Lake Erie on the municipal road allowance, they will need to run the drainage tile under the municipal road known as McCormick Road;
- 4.) The Township agrees to permit the work on the road under certain conditions:
 - i. That Pelee Farms shall at their own cost, to the satisfaction of the Roads Superintendent:
 - a. Repair the road in good and proper state of repair and safety to the original standing of the road; and
 - b. Comply with such further and additional requirements, as may be required by the Superintendent, acting reasonably.
 - c. Follow specifications as set out in the Utilities Crossing Policy set out in By-Law 2010-16.
